## INFORMATION

There will be entertainment on Saturday evening in the arena so we will have to be out of the arena 4pm, so once entries have been received I will be able to work out the programme for the day.

Setting up arena: ***Will take place early on the Saturday morning and each Club with vaulters competing is expected to provide a helper – time will be advised when I know the number of entries.***

The starting time: ***To be confirmed after receipt of entries – as we have to be out of the arena by approximately 4pm.***

Uniform: Vaulters **must** wear either their **school t-shirt or tracksuit** when not competing. It is accepted that families cannot afford to purchase unitards etc. for one event!

These cards are to be handed in by the Club's Team Manager at the Chef d'Equipe's meeting.

Music: Please prepare music in the same way as for previous competitions. Will advise in due course as to where to send it.

Horse points : Horse points will be strictly administered. *As per latest EFA Vaulting Rules.*

**Accommodation:** *Check the EFA Conditions of Entry & Information –these Entry/Booking forms need to be forwarded direct to EFA by 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2009*

**Stabling:** *Check the EFA Conditions of Entry & Information – this Booking form needs to be forwarded direct to EFA by 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2009*

**Grading/Raking the arena:** Raking might need to be done between grading by SIEC so please bring a rake with you.

**Horses' "looking-time" in arena** *TBC – will depend on what time we are starting.*

**Arm Numbers :** Clubs are to supply their own numbers for their teams. Numbers for individuals will be available for collection by the Club's Team Manager at the Chef d'Equipe's meeting at **TBA**. **A refundable deposit of \$5. per vaulter is required – a blank endorsed cheque will be accepted if preferred – please do not forget to bring cash or cheque to the Chef d'Equipe's meeting.**

**Canteen:** It is to be confirmed whether Arena Canteen will be open.

**Presentation:** Presentation of ribbons will take place at the end of the competition on Saturday.

**Merchandize:** Merchandize can be ordered (as per Order form with the EFA schedule). No guarantee that there will be adequate sizes left for sale over the week-end and they will not be dated 2009.

**Rosters -** it is expected that Clubs will provide helpers to assist with: **Setting up on Saturday morning will be VERY EARLY, together pencillers, time-keepers, gear steward, marshals, runners, rakers, etc.**

**Equipment:** Could each Club bring along rakes and 'poopa scoopers' for use in the arena/stables.

**Please make sure that you print out and read the EFA Interschool conditions of entry and information carefully – obviously there are some points that are not relevant to vaulting – but the vast majority do and will be applied!**
