Participation ribbons for all competitors

South Australian Champion trophies will be awarded to the winner of the highest canter/canter class
“Best Individual Vaulting Horse of the Championships”

Horses’ 5 minute lunge in the arena and training times - Between 7.30am and 8.30am on Sunday horses will be allowed a short session in the main arena.

Arm Numbers – Groups are to supply their own numbers for their teams. Numbers for individuals will be available

Performance Cards - Each vaulter in official classes must have a valid Performance Card. Performance cards must be handed in to secretary’s office before the start of comp.

Class size - Depending on the number of entries, classes may be split (on an “age” basis or abilities). The Organising Committee reserves the right to delete or combine classes.

Vaulters are eligible to compete in:

- a) Individual Horse
- b) Team Horse
- c) Team Barrel
- d) Pas de Deux Horse
- e) Pas de Deux Barrel

Music – Music for running in/out, compulsories and freestyle will be required to be in MP3 format on CD or Memory stick. Files are to be labelled with the **vaulter's name, Group and class** and be handed to the music coordinator at least an hour before commencement of competition. The organising committee will not be held responsible for any fault relating to music.

Horse points –will be strictly administered. *As per EFA Vaulting TBA*
